DEBTOR'S MOTION TO SHORTENT TIME TO OBJECT TO DEBTOR'S MOTION TO COMPEL TURNOVER

P. 9006(c), hereby moves the Court to shorten the time for parties to object to the Motion to Compel Turnover of Estate Property on Shortened Notice (the "Motion to Compel"), filed contemporaneously herewith, on the grounds that shortening the time to object would promote the expeditious and economical administration of the chapter 11 case.

- 1. Rule 9006(c) permits a court to reduce the notice period for cause. Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(c), with certain exceptions not implicated by the instant request.
- 2. Here, the case was filed on June 16, 2025. Debtor has filed its schedules and anticipates having to amend the schedules to account for changes resulting from the information that Debtor seeks to obtain from Mr. Southwell.
- 3. In the spirit of expeditiously disclosing information to creditors and to prevent delaying any motion to assume and assign Debtor's executory contracts, cause exists to reduce the notice period to nine (9) days.
