#### II. Motion

  - a. All documents concerning surety or other bonding issued to Lexington, Blue, Inc. for roofing work to be performed from May 1, 2020 to the present;
  - b. All correspondence between Liberty Mutual Insurance from January 1, 2020 to the present;
  - All claims made against any surety bonds issued to Lexington Blue, Inc. from May 1, 2020 to the present; and
  - d. All policies of insurance and declarations pages for any policy issued by Liberty Mutual Insurance to Lexington Blue, Inc. for January 1, 2020 to the present.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order directing Liberty Mutual Insurance to produce and submit to the examination of these documents pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2004 at the offices of Satterley & Kelley, PLLC, 8700 Westport Road, Louisville, Kentucky 40242, and authorizing the undersigned counsel to compel production of the documents described herein.
