# STATUS REPORT IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR AN ORDER SEALING PERSONAL INFORMATION AND ESTABLISHING LIMITED NOTICE PROCEDURES AND A MASTER MAILING LIST

Lexington Blue, Inc. (Debtor, "LB, or "the company"), by and through counsel submits this status report in support of its motion to file under seal the mailing list for its consumer creditors [ECF No. 8]; and establish limited notice procedures [ECF No. 13]. Debtor seeks to apprise the Court of the status of the case, and to clarify the procedures that it proposes to take to ensure that all parties are afforded a reasonable opportunity to participate in these proceedings.

#### Introduction.

- 1. Debtor recognizes that this case bears the hallmarks of a chapter 7 case rather than a chapter 11 reorganization. Indeed, a chapter 7 trustee is best suited to liquidate the assets of the company for the benefit of the creditors.
- 2. Debtor believes, however, that proceeding under a chapter 11 would be in the best interest of the creditors because:
  - (a) Debtor's plan to leverage the value of the executory contracts, with little to no additional expenditures, could reduce the pool of general unsecured creditors by satisfying claims owed to the former LB customers (the "LB Customers"), thereby increasing the recovery for the estate and all creditors.
  - (b) Debtor made significant progress on developing notice procedures, websites, and other digital solutions that could support the assumption and assignment of the Customer Contracts within 60 to 90 days.
  - (c) The potential for estate recoveries in this case, (as discussed below), will allow Debtor to develop a plan of liquidation before the value of the Customer Contracts is wasted by the passage of time; and

(d) Debtor's request to keep under seal the personal information of the LB Customers is necessary to protect estate assets from undue competition and allow for the assignment of the executory contracts (the "Customer Contracts"), in a decent and orderly fashion.

### **STATUS REPORT**

#### **Schedules and Statements.**

- 3. Debtor filed the balance of the petition on Friday, June 11, 2025. To complete the petition, Debtor has been working from three primary sources of information, including paper copies of bank statements, the company's QuickBooks Online account ("QBO"), and the reports downloaded from the company's Acculynx<sup>1</sup> account ("Acculynx").
- 4. The bank statements are incomplete and not reconciled with QBO. Likewise, a comparison of Acculynx with QBO show discrepancies that indicate that the information stored in these two sources are not reconciled with one another.
- 5. Debtor has already commissioned a third party who exported all Acculynx data and documents related to the Customer Contracts. Debtor will have to hire a third-party bookkeeping service to clean up QBO and reconcile it with Acculynx, and the company's bank statements.
- 6. The Debtor anticipates retaining a third-party bookkeeping service with money from recoveries, or an infusion of capital if any such commitment is available.

### **Potential Recoveries.**

7. Accounts Receivable. Deeper research into Debtor's QBO reveals that Debtor could be owed up to \$1.6M for work that has been completed but unpaid. Many of these accounts are aging by more than one year. Because of the real possibility that some of the accounts receivable include open balances on contracts that were never performed, recovering any amounts for unpaid work can only be pursued after a careful three-way reconciliation of the bank accounts, Acculynx, and QBO.

- 8. Transfers to Help with Creditors. Debtor sent a demand for the turnover of funds that were transferred prior to the petition to a certain Commercial Credit Systems, LLC to help resolve debts owed to various merchant cash advance companies ("MCAs"). Debtor is awaiting a response but has filed motion for 2004 examination of CCL in order to move the process along. The recovery of these funds is expected to yield \$100K to \$200K for the benefit of the estate.
- 9. <u>Potential Recoveries from MCAs</u>. Debtor is also investigating whether it can recover approximately \$300K transferred to the MCAs prior to the petition and has filed 2004 examination toward that end.
- 10. <u>Potential Preference Actions</u>. Debtor is investigating potential recoveries of funds transferred to JP Morgan Chase Bank, NA, and Bluevine, Inc. which appear to be preferential and avoidable. Motion for 2004 examinations have been filed to obtain relevant records.

### Omnibus motions to assume and assign executory contracts.

- 11. Debtor has developed a suite of digital documents that will be used to solicit and gather bids from contractors who wish to assume one or more bundles of executory contracts with the LB Customers.
- 12. Based on Debtor's preliminary calculations, the assignments would be valuable to subcontractors because the remaining balance due under bundled Customer Contracts could still yield a profit.
- 13. Debtor also is continuing to develop a list of contractors from which Debtor could solicit bids. Debtor anticipates taking advantage of the media coverage of Lexington Blue has garnered to further publicize the opportunity and attract qualified third-party contractors.
- 14. Debtor will request limited notice procedures for omnibus motions on a case-by-case basis, closer to the time when contractors are selected in accordance with the bidding process.

### Motion to Seal.

- 15. Debtor maintains that personally identifiable information of the LB Customers is Debtor's commercial information that is covered under §107(b) and needs to be protected from exposure to the marketplace.
- 16. Debtor believes that releasing the customers' contact information into the public arena would expose the LB Customers to unwanted solicitations from competitors and undermine the bidding process contemplated in this case.

### **Modified Limited Notice Procedures.**

- 17. After carefully considering the arguments and comments made at the time of the first hearing on Debtor's Motion for an Order Establishing Limited Notice Procedures and a Master Mailing List, Debtor has modified its approach to limited service and the contents that it proposes to provide to the LB Customers. (A diagram outlining the procedures that Debtor intends to implement to manage the mailing lists is provided in <a href="Exhibit 1">Exhibit 1</a> and discussed below).
- 18. Debtor proposes to provide the LB Customers with the option to "opt in" or "opt out" of the limited-service procedures, which calls for electronic service on LB Customers with valid email addresses.
  - (a) LB Customers would be directed through mail and email notifications to a website (bk-lexingtonblue.com; Exhibit 2). Both the website and any emails would in turn direct the recipients to an online form that could be used to "opt in" or "opt out" to receive electronic notices. The page has a link to the Pacer.gov site and to a subpage that reproduce the case docket and allows visitors to download the case filings. (See Exhibit 3). The docket and new documents will be updated on a weekly basis.
  - (b) LB Customers who "opt-in" to receive electronic notices would be included on an Email Service List and be notified of matters that affect their interests by electronic means; except that matters related to case deadlines would also be served by US First Class Mail (as provided in the original motion). In all cases, LB Customers that opt-in could later choose to opt-out of service by email and in turn be included on the Master Mailing List.
  - (c) LB Customer who "opt-out" of receiving electronic notices would be served by US First Class Mail regardless of whether Lexington Blue has a valid email address for

- those customers. Such customers could later choose to opt-in to email service and in turn be included in the Email Service List.
- (d) LB Customers who neither opt-in nor opt-out, would be included in the Email Service List if they have a valid email address; and on the Mailing List where there is no valid email address.
- 19. Based on this modified approach, Debtor has developed intake procedures to manage the service lists, (Exhibit 1), which it intends to adopt if Debtor's motion is granted.
- 20. Debtor has furthermore modified its intake form and the receptionist script to ensure clear messaging that complies with the rules of professional responsibility. See <u>Exhibit 4</u>; intake forms.
- 21. Counsel for Debtor is competent and has developed the digital infrastructure to manage the limited notice procedures. Below is an overview of the results from the notifications to and the service of process on LB Customers at this stage of the proceedings.
  - (a) Debtor identified 263 LB customers who made deposits under contracts for work not yet performed. (The "Customer Contracts").
  - (b) Debtor knows the physical address to the property to be serviced under each Consumer Contract. Debtor also knows the phone number for each LB Customer.
  - (c) Debtor does not have an email address for 31 of the 263 LB Customers.
  - (d) Debtor has discovered that 2 LB Customers had invalid emails.
  - (e) On June 20, 2025, Debtor sent an email notifying 230 LB Customers of the first day motions. Of those, 216 were successfully delivered, and 14 emails were undeliverable.
  - (f) Of the 216 emails delivered 130, or 60.19% of the recipients, opened the email. And of the 130 recipients who opened the email, 48 clicked on a link in the email.
  - (g) As of the day of this writing:

- (i) 30 recipients have filled out digital contact information forms;
- (ii) Debtor has received 22 email responses, including one email from a creditor who visited the website.
- (iii) Debtor's counsel has fielded 5 phone calls from LB Customers, and one phone call from a former employee.
- (h) Debtor served the Notice of Chapter 11 Filing by mail on all creditors [ECF No.
- 22. Debtor can commit to updating the Court on the status of the Master Email List and the Master Mailing List on a monthly basis.
- 23. Debtor in possession respectfully requests the entry of an order adopting the proposed limited notice procedures with the modifications proposed above.


